3. Grants

Mark Harris reported that we have received cheque for £2.7K from the Chill Out fund and that he had instructed TS Play to proceed with the proposed shelter. He also requested to provide two picnic benches at an additional cost of £500. He asked and received approval from the Parish Council. The shelter will be finished in November. He also stated that he will make provision for a tree to be planted in Neil's memory. It has been noted that the Playground is being well used.

4. Brize Norton and villages Facilitating Meeting

Rod has submitted the petition to WODC and has received the minutes from Alvescot, Carterton, Filkins and Brize Norton Facilitating Meeting. He is awaiting further details of how the matter is progressing.

5. Air Traffic Noise

There has been an increase complaints concerning aircraft noise; resulting in an invitation to a daytime meeting at Brize Norton. However, it has been requested that it is moved to evening time so that people do not have to take time out of work.

Another invitation to a Briefing Meeting concerning S106 funding and community infrastructure is to be held on Monday, October 12th at Filkins Village Hall.

6. Traffic Control Limiters

Mark Harris has emailed the Highways concerning the drop in the road at the old Langford railway bridge. Andrew to follow up with Cllr Don Searle, who advised the AGM that there was a sum of money available for limiters, to see what the position is and if the funding is still available.
