On Thursday Evening the 10th of Decr 1833
the holders of Allotments attended in the
Select Room according to notice, and the
Resolutions passed at the Meeting of the
previous week were announced to them.
Mr. H. H. H. H. H. Chairman, having
the aforesaid Resolutions to the vote, &
both were carried by the unanimous
consent of all present. A slight
alteration in each of the aforesaid
Rules was then made, and they
now stand as follows -
1st The Rents for the Allotment stands
shall henceforward be taken on the
Monday before the 1st Day of January
next.
2nd The Gift Coal shall be distributed
on the 1st week in January for this
and all future years.
A 3rd Deputation was on this occasion
announced by the Chairman; namely

that Attorneys of Land shall not-
henceforward be transferred from one
Tenant to another without permission
of the Trustees. It was explained to
the Meeting, that no one has a legal
right to give possession of any portion
of the Land except the legal Trustees
themselves, who are the Parish Officers,
that is, the two Churchwardens, the
two Overseers of the Poor, being, and
the Vicar.

At this Meeting, besides a majority
of the Tenants of Attmout Land, there
were present Mr. D. G. G. Thompson, three
Churchwardens, and Mr. H. Thompson Esq.
