In the Indenture Award of 1808 here is  
the following entry :

The Vicar,  
Churchwardens  
& Overseers  
of the poor of  
Langford

also for the Rev. ——— Johnson, Vicar,  
Thomas ——— and William Partridge,  
Churchwardens, and Robert Cook and  
Paul Ghet (?), overseers of the poor  
of Langford and their successors in  
trust being in trust for the poor  
inhabitants of Langford & and in  
trust of their lands, grounds and rights  
— 4 acres 0 m<sup>2</sup> 6 p<sup>2</sup>ches. —

The aliment-holders pay the rent to  
Miss Bechinsale at the Post Office, who hands  
it over to Mr. Richard Kirby — since the  
retirement of Rev. David Lane.

The Trustees are, I believe, Richard Kirby,  
Mervyn Ghet and Bob Laford.
