Meeting of the Trustees on 5th August, 1992

1. Apologies

The Trustees received the apologies of the Vicar, Mr W.L.Glazebrook.

2. Chairmanship

The Trustees elected Mr Richard Kirby as Chairman for the ensuing year.

3. Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of Representative Trustees on 26th May, 1992, distributed with the agenda, were confirmed.

4. The future of the Langford Coal Charities

Having considered the paper on the future of the Langford Coal Charities, distributed with the agenda, the Trustees agreed to take an initiative:

- (1) towards combining
 - (a) the Robert Day Charity, with an income of about £55 a year and the Vicar and Churchwardens as Trustees, with the object of providing coal among twelve poor widows and widowers native of and resident in the parish of Langford with
 - (b) the United Charities, with an income of about £45 a year and the object of distributing coal among the poor of Langford;
- (2) towards the alteration of the object of the combined charity from the provision of coal to the poor to the provision of help in meeting the costs of heating or lighting for Langford residents reliant on old age pensions or unemployment/social security benefits.
- (3) towards the orderly administration of the charity in compliance with the requirements of the law.
